**AMMENDMENT TO THE PROCEDURE TO AWARD AND
PAYMENT OF SUPPORT SERVICES FOR THE
YOUTH PROGRAM**

In order to provide adequate and necessary economic support to the participants of the Youth Program, the Local Board has determined to increase the economic compensation received by them during their participation in the activities. To this end, Section VII, Rules of Adjudication, subsection A, of the Procedure adjudication and payment of Services of Youth Support Program, is amended in the following terms and conditions:

- A. Stipend: This service will be offered to participants registered in the elements of the Youth Program, which do not carry salaries, and which require them to participate in the activity. Except, the element of development of occupational skills aimed at obtaining a credential. The latter will be granted NRP. The stipend is the equivalent of an assisted compensation . In the particular case of the youth in the school, they will be offered a compensation of \$ **20.00** daily per day attended and the youth outside the school will be offered a compensation of \$ **40.00** per day attended. **Those trainings where the day exceeds 5 hours, the following will be taken into consideration :**

- **Youth at school can receive up to a maximum of \$30.00 daily.**
- **Youth outside the school may receive up to a maximum of \$50.00 daily.**

This is subject to the availability of funds. If the participant is absent part of the

day or all of the day, the payment will be deducted proportionally. The participant is not an employee of the Mayagüez-Las Marias Local Labor Development Area, so he will not accumulate or qualify for marginal benefits, such as: regular vacation, sick leave, leave to take job examinations and interviews, maternity and paternity leave, funeral leave, probation leave, leave for judicial purposes or official summonses, accused, interested party, witness or jury, military leave, and insurance for unemployment. The payment of the holidays and those conceded to the Governor, or the Mayors will not be authorized.

This amendment will take effect from 1 April 2021.
