# PUBLIC POLICY FOR FEE COLLECTION OF SUPPLIERS' PROPOSALS FILINGS \_ FOR YOUTH PROGRAM AND INDIVIDUALIZED CAREER SERVICES

### I. INTRODUCTION

The Mayaguez - Las Marias Local Labor Development Area (Local Area) was appointed, by the Governor of Puerto Rico, to serve as jurisdiction for the administration of activities aimed to the development of the labor force and the execution of funds assigned to the programs for Adults, Displaced Workers, and youth, delegated by the State, as established within the Law of Opportunities and Workforce Innovation Policy (WIOA), approved by the Congress of the United States of North America, on the 22th of July of 2014.

#### II. LEGAL BASIS

- Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA), Sections 107 (d) (10) (B) (D), 123 (a),

#### III. PUBLIC POLICY

The WIOA Law and its Interpretive Regulations establish that the Local Board may issue grants or contracts to develop the activities (elements) of the Youth Program, as well as the



services of Individualized careers.

Given this, the Mayaguez Local Labor Development Board -Las Marias (Local Board) has

determined the following:

1. A charge (fee) will be collected in the amount of one hundred and fifty dollars

(\$150.00), in a manager's check or money order payable to the Mayagüez- Las

Marias Local Area Labor Development, for every three proposals submitted.

2. The manager's check or money order will be delivered to the Payment Officer of the

Finance Office or authorized agent. The officer or authorized agent will provide a

receipt and a copy of it shall be attached to the submitted proposal.

3. This fee does not apply to government entities, including the state university, which

submits proposals related with the Youth Register and Individualized Careers Services.

IV. APPROVAL AND VALIDITY

This public policy will take effect immediately after its approval. It will be responsibility of the

Executive Director to inform the personnel, within the five (5) days after its approval.
