

PUBLIC POLICY FEE FOR FILING PROPOSALS SERVICE PROVIDERS YOUTH PROGRAM AND INDIVIDUALIZED CAREER SERVICES

I. INTRODUCTION

The Mayagüez-Las Marías Local Workforce Development Area (Local Area) was designated, by the Governor of Puerto Rico, to serve as jurisdiction for the administration of workforce development activities and the execution of funds from their Adult, Dislocated Worker, and Youth Programs, delegated by the State, as established in the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA). approved by the Congress of the United States of America, on July 22, 2014.


III. PUBLIC POLICY

The WIOA Law and its Interpretative Regulations establish that the Local Board may grant grants or contracts to develop the activities (elements) of the Youth Program, as well as the services of Individualized Careers. Given this, the Mayagüez-Las Marías Local Labor Development Board (Local Board) has determined the following:

1. A charge (fee) in the amount of one hundred and fifty dollars (\$150.00) will be made in the form of a manager's check or money order made payable to the Mayagüez-Las Marías Local Labor Development Area for every three (3) proposals submitted.
2. The manager's check or money order will be delivered to the Paying Officer assigned to the Finance Office, or to his authorized representative, who will give him a receipt and a copy of it will be delivered with the proposals to be filed.
3. This fee does not apply to government entities, including the state university, that file proposals related to Youth Registries and Individualized Career Services.

IV. APPROVAL AND VALIDITY

This public policy will come into force immediately after approval. It shall be the responsibility of the Executive Director to inform staff within five (5) days of its approval.
